Registration Information

The registration fee for the 2010 SR-9 Winter Retreat will be \$12 per participant if paid by January 15, 2010. Each lodge should write a check payable to the Tukabatchee Area Council as explained on the Retreat Registration Form. After January 15, 2010, the fee will be \$15.

Participants must be approved by their scout executive or lodge adviser and will pre-register through their lodge. Individual registrations will not be accepted. Individuals needing to register late will be checked in by their contingent leader.

The lodge adviser or his designated representative should plan to register his contingent on-site on Friday, February 5. Please indicate the individual who will register the contingent on your Retreat Registration Form. The person designated to register each lodge will be expected to arrive as early as possible, hopefully prior to the bulk of his lodge's contingent. He should turn in the roster with the appropriate information filled out for each pre-registered participant and a photo-copied medical form for each preregistered participant. He will receive the appropriate number of participant armbands for his contingent, which will be used for admission to all retreat events and dining. Anyone not wearing the armband may be asked to leave the camp property. All known late registrations will be handled at this time.

If staying in cabins, the lodge will check in at Camp Hobbs. If staying in tents, the lodge will check in at Camp Tukabatchee.

Meals & Meetings

Meals and the main meetings will be held at the Camp Tukabatchee dining hall. Other meetings will be held on the dining hall porch or around the athletic field.

Accommodations

Participants will be housed at Camp Hobbs or in personal tents at Camp Tukabatchee. Camp Hobbs cabins are not heated, but small heaters may be brought. Proper toilet facilities will be provided, but running water may not be available if there is a hard freeze expected. The ranger will do his best to offer showers.

Parking

Participants who chose to stay at Camp Hobbs will have to walk between camps (15 minute walk) or drive. Youth will not be permitted to drive between camps.
